Dear guest,

Welcome to our beach. We particularly care about your safety and that of your family. For that reason we kindly ask you to read carefully the following regulation in which state the general and safety rules of our beach.

Enjoy your stay.

Beach general rules

1. It is prohibited to sublet the beach umbrella to third parties for a fee.
2. It is recommended that guests always follow the safety rules.
3. Guests must carry with them the documentation proving their entitlement to use the services offered by the beach in order to show it if requested by the authorised staff.
4. No refunds are contemplated for any reasons i.e. second thoughts, bad weather conditions, high tide, early departures.
5. The standard equipment for each beach position is composed by: **1 umbrella and 2 sunbeds**. Any other request will be assess by the beach reception.
6. One extra element can be added to each beach position - which can be an extra sunbed or an extra sun chair (just one extra element is allowed).
7. The standard equipment for each gazebo at the beach facility of the Sports Center is composed by: **2 sunbeds, 2 sun chairs and 2 chairs and one box for personal items**.
8. One extra element can be added to each beach position, one extra sun chair or an extra sunbed or a chair (just one extra element is allowed).
9. A maximum of 4 people is allowed under one umbrella. A maximum of 8 people is allowed under a gazebo. Guests are advised not to exceed this number.
10. It is not permitted to occupy other guests' spots, even if they appear to be unoccupied.
11. **SUNBEDS AND SUN CHAIRS MAY NOT BE TAKEN FROM OTHER BEACH POSITIONS.**
12. Sun beds and sun chairs cannot be moved from their assigned position in order not to bother the other guests.
13. It is forbidden to hang or drape towels, beach towels, or wet clothing over the beach umbrella, for aesthetic, hygiene, and material durability reasons.
14. The daily reservation of beach services is available online (www.albarella.it) or from 4.30 pm of the day before at the Beach Reception Desk.
15. For beach umbrellas, the half-day rate starts from 2.30pm.
16. Any behavior that is improper, unbecoming or likely to bother other guests is not allowed.
17. It is prohibited to access the beach by bike or with other electric vehicles that can cause damages to equipment or people.
18. Each guest has to use the equipment in a responsible way, taking care not to damage it. The staff of the beach must be informed of any malfunction of the equipment.
19. Albarella srl does not take responsibility **for any unattended object and/or material belonging to the guest** i.e. money, precious objects, clothes, air mattress and any other personal object.
20. It is forbidden to put any belongings and/or personal beach equipment under the bought beach position and in other area of the beach i.e. personal sun chairs, sunbeds, umbrellas, tents or any other personal equipment not provided by us.
21. The portion of the beach between the first row of umbrellas and the foreshore must always remain free.
22. Sports activities and games are allowed in the sport area only (i.e. volleyball, football, bowls). No liability is accepted for damage to person or property caused by sporting activities.

23. For the safety of our guests, holes dug in the beach for play, which must be small, must always be covered.
24. Animals of any kind may not be brought to the beach, even if muzzled or leashed, with the exception of guide dogs for the blind people.
25. **Animals are admitted exclusively in the beach areas dedicated to them**, in compliance with the relevant regulations.
26. Bathrooms, sinks and showers must be left tidy and clean. It is not permitted to use shampoo and bubble bath in the showers on the beach.
27. It is forbidden to throw cigarette butts or other rubbish on the beach.
28. Rubbish must be placed in the appropriate containers, differentiated by type. It is forbidden to deposit them even temporarily in any other place.

Playground equipment- kids' area

The equipment of the playground must be used in presence of parents or adults. The Albarella srl takes no responsibility for the improper use of the equipment. Children do not have to use the playground equipment when these are wet. It is forbidden to eat when using the playground equipment. Children must wear a proper clothing during the use of the playground equipment i.e. clothing without cords, dangling ends that could become entangled.

Meaning presence and colour of the flag

Green flag: indicates the absence of known or evident hazards for bathing.

Yellow flag: indicates the presence of a potential hazard or a moderate, concrete risk for bathing, which is therefore not recommended under such circumstances.

Red flag: indicates maximum danger for bathing or the absence of lifeguard service.

Safety rules in the beach

For emergencies at sea, **the blue number 1530** of the Harbour Master's Office (Capitaneria di Porto) is available 24/7.

In case the sea condition is judged dangerous or there are dangerous situations, the red flag will be raised. Albarella srl takes no responsibility towards those who do not observe this warning. The rental of equipment such as pedalo and canoes will also be suspended.

On days of strong wind, the beach umbrellas must be kept closed. Each Guest, in these circumstances, is obliged to observe the instructions of the beach staff.

It is forbidden to stay on the lifeboat, touch the equipment provided for this purpose (lifebuoys, rescue boards, jet skis, etc...) or to go up or stand in the area of the lifeguard tower.

Do not get away from the flags marking the "safe waters".

Swimming is not recommended unless you are in perfect physical and mental condition and at least 3 hours have passed since your last meal.

The guests must observe all the above-motioned, in the Ordinance regulating bathing activities of the Municipality of Rosolina, and in the bathing safety ordinance of the Harbour Master's Office of Chioggia (Capitaneria di porto di Chioggia). All documents are displayed at the entrance of the beach. Failure to comply with the rules will be punished by removing the offender from the establishment.
